

## Beers/Ciders

3.5 - Miller Lite

4 - Non-Alcoholic Beer

6 - **Dry Cider** - ABV 6.5 - Shackbury Cider (G) (Shoreham, VT)  
Inspired by saison beers, this cider is light bodied, refreshing, & dry.

6 - **Volcano Juice** - ABV 4.1 - Halyard Brewing Company (G) (Burlington, VT)  
A ginger beer shandy brewed with Sicilian volcanic lemons.

5 - **White Ale** - ABV 5.0 - Allagash Brewing Company (Portland, ME)  
A Belgian style wheat beer with a hazy body, coriander, & orange with smooth bready flavors and fruity aromas.

5 - **House Lager** - ABV 5.2 - Jack's Abbey Brewing (Framingham, MA)  
Sweet & golden with a full malty body that comes from traditional German malt. Smooth & easy drinking.

5 - **Cone Head IPA** - ABV 5.7 - Zero Gravity Brewery (Burlington, VT)  
Single hop wheat IPA brewed with citra hops. Lighter in color & lower in ABV than a typical American IPA, this beer has just the right amount of hop flavor & aroma.

5 - **Oatmeal Stout** - ABV 5.3 - Brown's Brewing Company (Troy, NY)  
Velvety smooth oatmeal stout with darkly roasted malts and rich notes of coffee & chocolate. Taste simple & direct with excellent drinkability

## White

9/34 - **Badissa**, Pinot Grigio (Veneto, IT)  
A delicate fragrance of citrus and honey leads to a bright, grassy, acidic mouthfeel with a touch of creaminess.

9/34 - **Lobster Reef**, Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, NZ)  
Herbal aromas & lemongrass, tomato, & celery leaf float from the glass. Lighter in body yet alive with light pepper & citrus filling the mouth, classically finishing with soft white grapefruit

36 - **Boundary Breaks**, Ovid Line North Riesling (Finger Lakes, NY)  
Petrol, citrus, flowers, & eucalyptus are apparent on the nose. It drinks with a viscous, slight body that is medium dry & finishes more tart than it begins.

10/38 - **Hild, Elbling Trocken** (S) (Mosel, DE)  
Lesser known native of Germany comparable to Riesling, it has the familiar nose of petrol & stone fruit with a touch of citrus. Delicate on the palate in all manners: effervescence, body, acidity, & minerality, but finishes much longer.

9/34 - **Matchbook Wine Company**, Dunnigan Hills Chardonnay (Dunnigan Hills, CA)  
Soft buttery notes of oak and butterscotch are alive on the palate, while pear & honeydew combine with subtle spice for a lingering finish.

9/34 - **Domaine de la Motte**, Chardonnay (Languedoc-Roussillon, FR)  
Delicate color of light gold with hints of green. Supple homey, light ginger spice, and vanilla meld with fresh notes of fleshy apple, melon, and mango. Medium in body, it leaves a structured and pleasant finish.

9/34 - **Cave de Saumur, Les Pouches Blanc** (B) (Loire Valley, FR)  
Apricot & lemon curd linger on the nose, while the palate is greeted with beautiful apple acidity with a hint of minerality. Medium bodied & incredibly dry with a lasting finish.

45 - **Domaine François Pinon**, Vouvray Silex Noir (O) (Loire Valley, FR)  
100% Chenin Blanc, this is a unique white wine with an inspiring mineral character derived from clay, flint, & stone. Full & firm with touches of licorice, white flowers, & dried pears, it finishes with decisive acidity.

## Red

10/38 - **Christopher Michael**, Pinot Noir (OR)

Intense deep garnet in color unsurprisingly give way to dark, rich berries & dust on the nose. This 100% Pinot Noir is full of earth, mulberry, & plum, yet medium in body & finish.

45 - **Koehler-Ruprecht**, Pinot Noir Trocken (B) (Pfalz, DE)

An unfiltered 100% pinot noir that presents with bright cherries & strong must on the nose. Light in body, this wine balances perfectly for a long lasting mouth feel.

75 - **Anthill Farms**, Pinot Noir (Anderson Valley, CA)

This "cult wine" offers a true Burgundian style Pinot Noir utilizing selectively sourced grapes. Generous earth, subtle cherry, and dust empower the nose with a well balanced & lengthy finish of fruit & tannins.

10/38 - **Carlin de Paolo**, Terre Alfieri Nebbiolo (Piedmont, IT)

Intense nose with acids, black pepper, berries, & light flowers. Tart, bright, & acidic with strong tannins & a light body make a thirst quenching combination.

10/38 - **Altocedro**, Malbec (Mendoza, AR)

Dark in color, smoke & spice float from the glass. Big & bold with flavors of plum & wood spice.

47 - **MAAL**, Malbec Biolento (O) (Mendoza, AR)

A blend of peppercorn & juicy cherry greets the nose leading to a medium body mouthfeel of anise & light spice. Lightly acidic with a refreshing finish.

10/38 - **Angry Bunch**, Zinfandel (Lodi, CA)

Dark purple in color with aromas of raspberries and blackberries. Full bodied, jammy & juicy with flavors of blueberry, cassis and chocolate finishing with a hint of spice.

11/42 - **Roc desANGES**, L'Effet Papillon Rouge (B) (Languedoc-Roussillon, FR)

Dust & delicate flowers mix with prunes, dark currants, and blackberries on the nose. The palate shows a much drier wine with smooth tannins, a medium body, & a medium finish.

10/38 - **Laurent Family Vineyard**, Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva (B) (Valle del Maipo, CH)

Filled with green pepper, round oak, & subtle eucalyptus. Mouth fillingly bold with dark cherries, yet with medium tannins and acidity.

14/55 - **Michael David, Freakshow** Cabernet Sauvignon (Lodi, CA)

The nose begins with traditional green & white pepper. Faint spice, blueberry & blackberry are bold on the palate. This midnight dark wine finishes with velvety smooth tannins.

105 - **Frog's Leap**, Napa Valley Estate Cabernet Sauvignon (O) (Napa Valley, CA)

Intense aromas of dark fruit, blackberry & cassis with lovely overtones of mocha & coffee bean.

9/34 - **Cavicchioli**, 1928 Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry (S) (Emilia-Romagna, IT)

45 - **Meyer-Fonné**, Crémant d'Alsace Brut Extra (O) (Alsace, FR)

## Rosé

10/38 - **Domaine de la Sanglière**, Vin de Pays de Méditerranée Juliette Rosé (Provence, FR)

An elegant pairing of Grenache and Syrah offer the more lush raspberries & subtle strawberries. Bone dry yet yields to a crisp and open mouthfeel with a gentle, smooth, bright finis
